Interior Styling Process

Step 1 - Pre-Consultation

Prior to meeting with our Interior Designer, we ask you to take time to consider your living spaces including the functionality and what is currently not working for you. Identify what furniture or decorative pieces must stay and what can go. We recommend collecting images to identify your decorating style including images of furniture and art. We recommend using resources such as Pinterest or Houzz. You can also visit the MyPad Interior Styling Pinterest page to view our collection of images.

Step 2 - In Home Consultation

Our Interior Designer will meet with you to discuss how you would like to see your interior transformed. They will collect information on your space and discuss options for achieving your vision and work to suit your budget. Based on the meeting, the Interior Designer will create a custom proposal that includes a summary of your requirements and the suggested number of hours needed to create your space. This can be broken down into stages and managed over time based on your time frame and budget.

Step 3 - Sourcing

We access our database of wholesalers and retailers to curate the furniture and decorative items to create your unique interior. We develop a personalised Look Book that clearly outlines selections for each room including floor plans, images, dimensions, colour and cost.

Step 4 - The Presentation

We present our initial concept Look Book for review and allow one opportunity to provide a revision. Upon your approval, we provide you with the final Look Book.

Step 5 - Shop and Style

We can assist with the shopping including receiving deliveries and furniture assembly. Once all items are



received, our experienced Interior
Designer will visit
your home to style
and ensure the

Colour Schemes

Colour can define the entire look and feel of the home. A colour consultation enables you to establish a co-ordinated look for your home that incorporates the exterior and the interior. Our Interior Designer considers the undertone, the amount and direction of light that enters a room as well as the effect one colour can have on another. We take into consideration constraints of the site including flooring or window coverings. We consider the purpose of the room and how the colour can alter mood. Avoid confusion and frustration by enlisting a profressional.



Interior Colour Scheme

A standard interior colour scheme includes colours for the walls, doors, skirting boards, architraves and ceiling. A paint schedule including brush outs are provided. Feature wall colours or wall paper are costed in addition to the standard price.

Exterior Colour Scheme

A standard exterior colour scheme includes colours for Colorbond, render and painted areas. A paint schedule including brush outs are provided. Bricks, roof tiles or complex architectural details are costed in addition to the standard price.
